Action A1.1 Interview with Food Waste specialists/experts in the food service industry

Goal: to understand in deep and shape the development of a proper framework for the prevention of food waste in the food service industry. The integration of the information from the interviews (A1-1) with the results coming from the action A1.0 will constitute the base for the design of the “Training the Trainers” activity (B1) as well valuable inputs for actions C1 and C2.

The best method to reduce food waste in the restoration sector and the problems related will be the focus of the interview.

Target group: experts/specialists/trainers working on different elements/phases of food waste management in the food service industry.

In the interviews there are some questions (identified in red with the symbol *) dedicated to chefs/restaurant managers. You can try to propose these questions even to trainers (for kitchen and dining hall, but according to the situation the interviewee may be able to answer or not).

Interview structure:

- A. Interviewer & organization profile
- B. Drivers & motivations
- C. Opportunities, solutions and suggestions
- D. Barriers & constraints

Methodology: The interview is a combination of semi-structured and in-depth interview. This format provides a degree of structure in order to cover specific key questions relevant for the LIFE-Foster. If you prefer you can start from the B section and close with the A. For the other sections please follow the order of the questions' sequence and the instructions in order to properly fill the space for answer in the table.

Translation in national language: I ask to AFPA, CECE to translate in French and Spanish the interview where the target is not able to understand or speak in English fluently. For what concerns the answer I am able to read in French and Spanish, so do not translate them. For FIC and ENAIP-NET UNISG will provide the Italian version.
